ear Jewish Calgary, The High Holidays have passed, the municipal elections are behind us, and we congratulate our new Mayor, Jeromy Farkas, wishing him every success in his new role. The Blue Jays made our country proud but ultimately left many of us heartbroken. And while life continues here at home, we all remain deeply aware of events unfolding overseas.

These are truly historic times for the people of Israel. The living hostages have finally returned home as we collectively mourn and await closure for those who did not survive. Through it all, Israelis continue to embody the resilience, determination, and spirit that have defined their story since the nation's founding.

Having recently returned from Israel as part of our Coast-to-Coast Partnership with Federation leaders from across Canada, I was reminded again of the strength and hope that define our partner communities. Together with local Calgarians Cathy and Marty Cole, Joyce Kerr, and Rachel Simantov, I visited the Galilee Panhandle (Etzba HaGalil) to
